Welcome to our first newsletter of the new school term. It's amazing just how quickly the holidays seem to have flown in even with very little sunshine. This is an extra large version of our newsletter so that we can communicate to you all our news and timetables etc. We have a busy year planned so I would ask you to keep our little learning community in all your thoughts and prayers over the first few weeks of term.

New Faces to KPS: We are delighted this year to welcome fifteen new faces to P1, one new face to P3 and one to P5. We also welcome Mrs Houston to our school as a Learning Assistant. Our growing enrollment of 113 children means we as a school are now full unless the Department of Education lifts restrictions on our enrollment numbers.

Website & Social Media: Our website continues to be a valuable resource and source of information for our whole learning community. We will do our best to keep it updated and the Parent Area can give you access to a wide variety of information. Within the Pupil Area each class has a website with key information and documents unique to their class. As a school we are also on Facebook & Twitter for the use of our parents and wider community and not our children.

Modern Languages: Sadly due to government cut backs in the assembly the Department of Education no longer pays for modern language provision in our school. We are delighted however as a school to be able to continue to offer Spanish lessons to our children this year on a Friday. These will remain free to our pupils and are funded directly from our schools own budget as we see them to be a valuable addition to our little learners life skills. They will continue as long as funding permits.

PTA: Our school has an active and vital Parent & Teachers Association (PTA) who organize community activities and raise much needed funds for our school. They have plans already well underway for our annual Curran Duck Race on the River Moyola on Saturday 12<sup>th</sup> September. Families who have already sold tickets that went home in June are encouraged to return monies and the ticket stubs to the office as soon as possible.

# Starting times & absence notes:

To facilitate school transport provision our classes start at 8.50am. I must emphasize that all children in school at any stage before 8.45am will be expected to go to the Windmill Club in the assembly hall for supervision, breakfast and activity and parents will be billed accordingly.

Milk is 20p per day, so this half term will cost £6.60 from Monday 7th Sept. Please return slip on replies page if you wish to order. Our school is very fortunate to have Dorinda who is a superb cook & our school dinners remain a most popular option.
