Thursday 9th & 10th December we will be holding our Christmas Concert & Nativity in Knockloughrim Presbyterian Church Hall. On Monday 7th, & Tuesday 8th we will be having our rehearsals in Knockloughrim Presbyterian Church Hall. There will be no Breakfast Club running on these mornings next week as all pupils should be dropped off at Knockloughrim Presbyterian Church Hall on these mornings between 8.45 and 9.00am (please not before 8.45am). Children who require costumes should bring them with them on Monday morning in a bag with their name on it as we will be having our dress rehearsal. Everyone should bring their own break on both days as there will be no facility to provide break at 10.45am in the hall. We will return to school each day by bus in time for lunch. On Wednesday everyone can go home following the matinee performance and those parents/adults doing pick-ups from the hall, and who are not attending the matinee, should plan to collect their children from the Presbyterian Hall from 2.30pm. Those children who are booked into Windmill Club will be transported back to school by Education Authority transport. On Thursday 10th Dec. everyone will go home at 2pm. Our Christmas evening performance on Thursday 10th December is now SOLD OUT although we do still have seats remaining in our matinee performance at 1pm on Wednesday 9th December. Tickets are available from our office (Adults £4/Children 11yrs or under £2). During the performances drivers are asked to plan to car share if possible, as parking is limited in the church car park. We would ask that cars who do not make it into the church car park, park only on the left hand side of the Ballinacross Road as you travel towards the Church in either direction. This will keep one side of the road clear and allow for easy departure for everyone or emergency access in the unlikely event of it being needed.
